

LAKE OSWEGO A LEARNING COMMUNITY



Education is a core value of this community. Many people moved to Lake Oswego so their children could attend the top rated schools here. Lake Oswego also has a higher number of college graduates living here than in other parts of the state.

The concept of Lake Oswego as “Learning Community” was developed based on feedback from the community. This concept envisions a network of local education, culture and civic institutions that provide rich opportunities for lifelong learning and creative expression. The network is anchored by Marylhurst University, Portland Community College, and Lewis and Clark College; and supported by connections to the Oregon Health Sciences University and Portland State University. The nature of this vision is universal and may be considered for incorporation, in whole or part, into the three scenarios that survived the planning refinement process.
